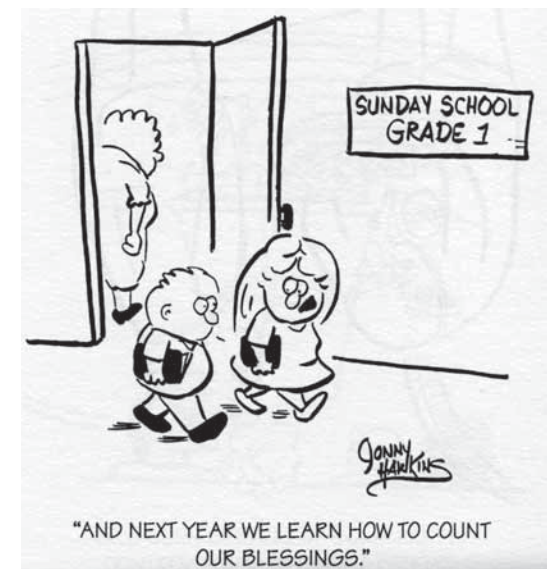
However, many today seem to misunderstand the nature of God's providence. If God does continue
