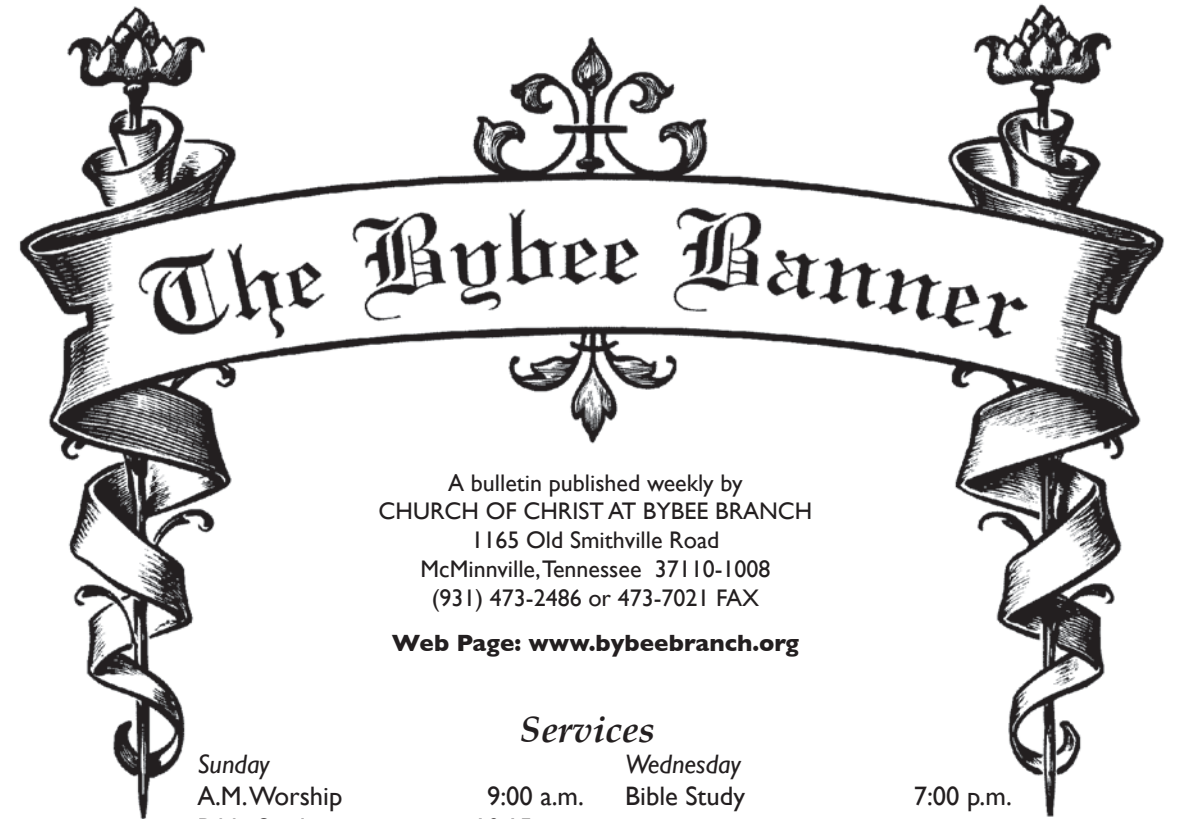

From Tyler's Desk:

It's a Miracle! ... or is it?

One of the most exciting football games I can recall occurred on January 8, 2000. It was the Wild Card round of the playoffs, featuring a game between the Tennessee Titans and the Buffalo Bills. The Titans won the game on an incredible kick off return for a touchdown with only 16 seconds left in the game. The game earned the nickname, "The Music City Miracle."

Although the game has earned a nickname which identifies the last play as a "miracle", I would be very surprised to find someone who actually believes that God is a Titans fan, and worked a miracle on that January day.

But with that said, many people do seem to misunderstand God's use of miracles today. If someone survives a serious car crash, it may be proclaimed "It's a miracle!" Or perhaps the same may be said about someone recovering from cancer, a paralytic learning to walk again, or a child who survives a serious illness. But are these really miracles?

As we have discussed in previous bulletin articles, it is clear that God works providentially today. That is, God has promised to provide for us, and works in the world to do so. But the way in which God works today is not the same thing as a "miracle" as seen in the Bible.

During Bible times, God would accomplish things which the forces of nature could not produce.

For example, God made the blind to see, people would speak in tongues (languages which they had not previously learned), and the dead would raise.

In I Corinthians 13, the inspired apostle Paul informed the Corinthians what would happen to their miraculous gifts. "As for prophecies, they will pass away; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away" (I Cor. 13:8). Paul goes on to explain that miracles only revealed God's will in part. In the scriptures, we now have God's fully revealed will (Jude 3), and therefore no longer have a need for miracles.

God continues to be very active in the world today, but the need for miracles has passed. God continues to answer our prayers. In fact, He has informed us that he is "able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think." But when we witness amazing things, we should be careful not to proclaim "It's a miracle!"

Ten Commandments for Husbands

1. Thou shalt remember that thy wife is thy partner and not thy property.
2. Thou shalt hold thy wife's love by the same means that thou won it.
3. Thou shalt enter thy house with cheerfulness.
4. Thou shalt not let anyone criticize thy wife and get away with it, neither thy father, nor thy mother, nor thy brothers, nor thy sisters, nor any other relative.
