- That your workers felt no obligation to explain where they had been when they were absent.

Lesson From Steve

God hates "A false witness who speaks lies, And one who sows discord among brethren," Proverbs 6:19. Why do some Christians feel they have the authority to go behind a brother or sister's back to tell lies and create division? Did Jesus not say, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and earth," Matthew 28:18? Did Jesus not give a stern warning against those who are angry with his brother without a cause, Matthew 5:22? Did Jesus not pray for unity, John 17? Why, then, would some individuals be so bent on destroying another's work based on false accusations and clever insinuations without first researching to see if such reports are true?

In the 2004 Bible Bowl our kids learned that Paul was determined to teach the Corinthians that division could not be a part of the Christian's life. As we studied the whole First Corinthian letter it became obvious that there were some in the church at Corinth who decided to do things their own way instead of God's way and the end result was division, and Paul condemned those actions as sin. Maybe divisive people strive for a following of their own (Acts 20:30.) Maybe division seekers just have a lot of time on their hands (I Timothy 5:13; 6:20-21.) Maybe those who are enamored with sowing discord have a "Diotrephes Complex" (III John 9-10.) Regardless, God's word (the final say on ALL matters) has eternally condemned division and those who practice it (Romans 15:4-6, I Corinthians 1:10, Romans 1:28-32.)

Therefore, our hope and prayer should be that the day would come when the church of Jesus Christ unites, not to fight each other, but to fight against the one who is laughing at our divisive ways – Satan. Imagine the possibilities.

In the meantime, forgive us all Father.
