

Notes From Steve

"The Lord has made known His salvation; His righteousness He has revealed in the sight of the nations" (Psalm 98:2.) Sometimes, husbands and wives do not communicate the best they should. A husband may not reveal his feelings openly, just like a wife may not reveal what she is looking for. Sometimes, around Christmas Eve when the kids have gone to bed and it's time to put that last toy together, you rip open the box to realize the instructions are missing along with certain vital parts! Sometimes, people are really, really sick, or need a friend, or just need to talk but do not reveal it to others until it is too late.

We struggle with relationships, sometimes, because we do not always express things up front and openly. We keep late hours, sometimes, because of a lack of communication. We suffer undue hardships, sometimes, because we do not reveal that we need help. Glory to our Father in heaven, however, that He has not left us in the dark on things pertaining to salvation!

We have a prime example of God's revealed plan in Acts chapter sixteen and the Philippian jailer. The iailer asked, "What must I do to be saved?" (vs. 30.) I cannot think of a more important guestion to ask. Paul and Silas immediately began to teach him of God's revealed plan of salvation. The jailer was first told. "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household" (vs. 31.) By necessity, faith (belief) has to be the first item on the road to salvation. If one does not believe that Jesus is the Christ, the conversion process cannot continue. But how does one gain faith or belief? Notice what happens next, "Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all who were in his house" (vs. 32.) Faith in God is revealed through His revealed word as stated in Romans 10:17, "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God "

What then was the result of hearing God's word? "And he took them the same night and washed their stripes. And immediately he and all his family were baptized" (vs. 33.) Was the jailer's act of washing Paul and Silas' stripes a sign of repentance? Did he understand they had been beaten for the cause of Christ? We are not told, but certainly Paul and Silas both knew and relayed to the jailer that an unrepentant person who is baptized is just getting wet! The jailer seemed to be sincere in his guestion for salvation and when the opportunity was presented he (and his household) obeyed the gospel of Jesus Christ. Again, "immediately...baptized." Just as in the case of the Ethiopian treasurer, it is intimated that the jailer was told and understood that baptism was essential for salvation. Not later... immediately, hence an urgency!

After the jailer and his household had been baptized, joy entered his life. **"Now when he had brought them into the house, he set food before them; and he rejoiced, having believed in God with all his household**" (vs. 34.) For those of you who may be reading this and are asking the same question that the jailer asked, I hope this information has helped. God would never leave salvation to chance. He has revealed everything we need to know. Turn to Him and find true joy, happiness, and peace that is only found through a loving and merciful Father.
