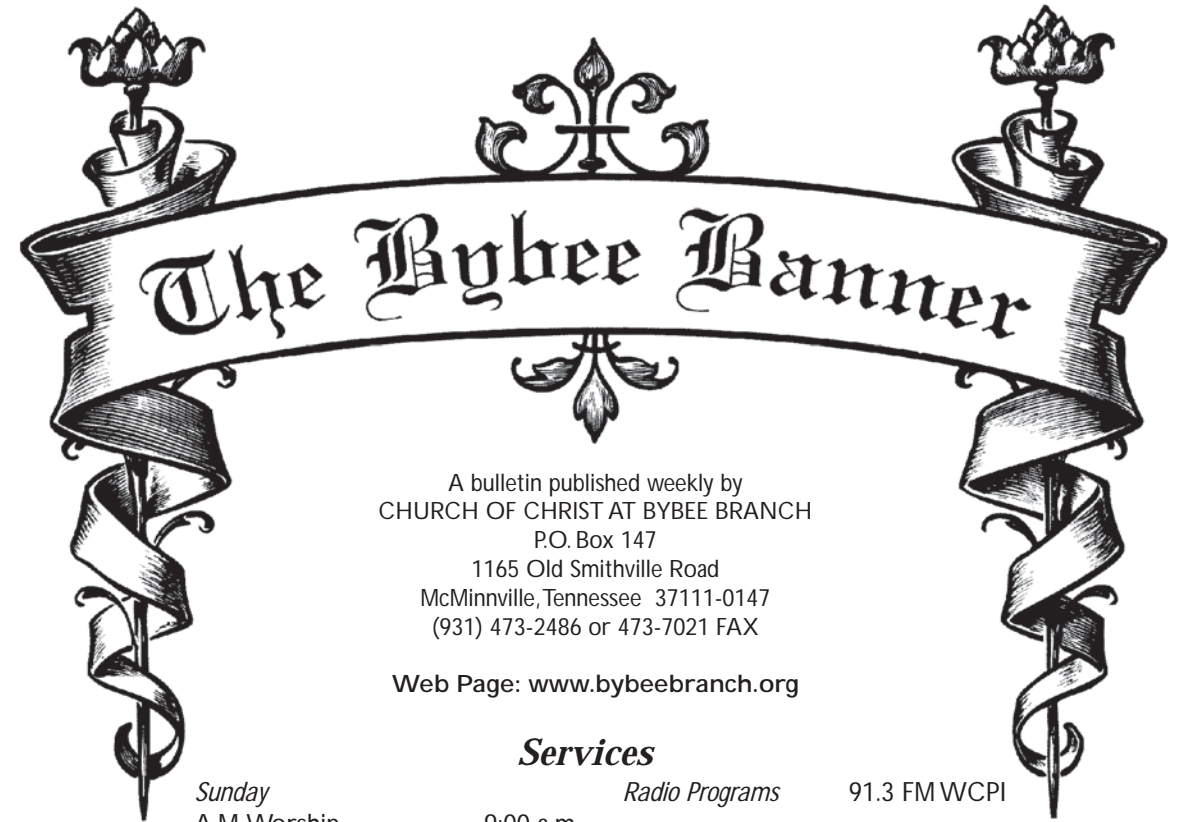

Notes From Steve

Since the early 1960's, literally thousands of Cubans have made attempts to cross the 90 miles of shark-infested waters in the hope of reaching the shores of Florida. Rafts that most of us would not even put in a swimming pool are used as an attempt to escape the oppression of Castro's regime. Scholars attribute between 30,000 to 40,000 Cubans have perished at

sea trying to escape. Why? "Libertad!" FREEDOM! The chance at a life that probably most Americans take for granted. FREEDOM!

Freedom is a concept that means different things to different people. Some dream of being debt-free, while some await release from prison.
