

# **Giving Thanks To God**

One of the beautiful words, among the many in the Bible, is the word "thanksgiving." This is true because this word is a reflection of our attitude toward God. How can we feel right toward Him if we are not thankful, since God is the giver of all blessings?

"Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning" (Jas. 1:17).

Therefore, how can we receive all of these gifts and then refuse to express gratitude to Him?

Someone might say, "I am grateful to God, but how do I show Him that I am?" The following are some suggestions that can help:

## (1) By the way we live

"but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:15, 16).

A tremendous price of love was paid to make salvation possible, and we must live our lives in a way that shows our thankfulness to God.

### (2) By the way we pray

Abraham Lincoln is quoted as saying: "I have been driven many times upon my knees by the overwhelming

conviction that I had nowhere else to go."

Since this is a truth needed by all Christians today, shouldn't we thank God for always being there for us? Paul admonished the Christians at Ephesus:

"giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ," (Eph. 5:20).

## (3) By the way we receive salvation

How do we feel about God's salvation? I expressed my feelings this way:
