

The first speaker will be brother William Woodson. Brother Woodson is an extremely talented teacher and preacher. "Standing for Their Faith: A History of Churches of Christ in Tennessee, 1900-1950," Sounding Brass and Clanging Cymbals: The History and Significance of Instrumental Music in the Restoration Movement (1827-1968)" and "Change Agents and the Churches of Christ." Brother Woodson continues to teach in the "School of Bible Emphasis" that meets at the Mt. Leo congregation during the school year on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4th Mondays. Be here to hear him preach!
