

There have been some very good and faithful Christians in this congregation. I have some sweet memories of some of these wonderful people. While there we grew from about 25 to 50. I am so thankful that these good brethren let me start preaching there. They were patient and kind with a young, inexperienced preacher. Two of its members were first cousins of mine. So it is with sadness that I think of the church there closing its doors.

On the other hand, when the church was begun it was when transportation was much different. Now numerous members of the Lord's church would drive by the building to attend larger congregations as it is just a few short miles down the road. There were few children and number of men capable of carrying on the work had dropped to just a handful. This action may result in some of those members getting involved in an active congregation. It has the potential to be an opportunity for spiritual growth.
