

### **Notes From Steve**

"Now it happened, as soon as Isaac had finished blessing Jacob, and Jacob had scarcely gone out from the presence of Isaac his father, that Esau his brother came in from his hunting" (Genesis 27:30.) The rest of the story could be summarized in one word...SURPRISE! The entire episode between Esau and Jacob combined with the actions of Jacob and his mother Rebekah are not simply explained. Was arrogance the downfall of Esau for despising and selling his birthright (Gen. 25:34; Heb. 12:16?) or was deception and lies by Jacob and Rebekah the underlying factor for the eldest son losing his birthright and blessing (Gen. 27:5-19?) I do not know, but we can look at some factors that may have played a part in determining the outcome of this event.

<u>First – Esau</u>. He initiated the problem by disregarding the privilege of having firstborn status (again reference Gen. 25:34; Heb. 12:16.) Maybe he thought (if he was thinking at all) that he would still receive the full package of his father's blessings. By the tone of Isaac, that seemed to be his intention (Gen. 27:24-29.)

<u>Second – Jacob</u>. In true Americana style, he was an opportunist. Isaac was a very wealthy man (Gen. 26:12-14) and the firstborn would gain the majority holding of material goods as well as the spiritual aspects of the blessing. When Esau presented himself on that fateful day, Jacob obliged. Jacob's capitalistic ways, however, cannot excuse the deception he practiced. He lied. Genesis 27:24 states, "Then he (*Isaac*) said, 'Are you really my son Esau?' He (*Jacob*) said, 'I am." (emp. mine.)

<u>Third – Rebekah</u>. I will not try to defend her actions. One thought that comes to my mind, though, is who exactly knew about what God had revealed to her? Did she feel that she had to take drastic measures to assure that God's plan would be carried out? Hearken back to when Rebekah was pregnant and the turmoil that was taking place within her (Gen. 25:21-22.) Here is what the Lord told her, **"Two nations are in your womb, Two peoples**  shall be separated from your body; One people shall be stronger than the other, And the older shall serve the younger" (Gen. 25:23.)

Esau had no problem in starting the process, Jacob had no problem in taking advantage of the situation, and Rebekah had divine knowledge that Esau would serve Jacob. So, this brings us to the real question or at least for me. Did God condone the means by which Jacob received his father's blessing? We will look at that question in depth next time.
