

Miracles in Mark: Who Should Be Afraid of Jesus?

Before reading this article, I encourage you to read the account of Jesus healing the demon possessed man in Mark 5:1-20. As we discuss this text, I encourage you to ask the questions, "Should I be afraid of Jesus?" and "Am I afraid of Jesus?".

When Jesus arrived in Gerasenes, he encountered a demon possessed man. In verse 7, we discover the fear the demon's had for Jesus. They said, "What have you to do with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I adjure you by God, do not torment me." They continued to show their fear of Jesus in verses 10-12 when the begged Him not to send them out of the country, but rather to send them into a herd of pigs.

The demons had every right to fear Jesus. From 1 John 3:8 we know that Jesus came to destroy the works of

the devil. The demons knew that Jesus would destroy them, and therefore they were afraid. We too should be afraid of Jesus if we make a practice of sinning, and joining in those works of the devil. If you have not repented or been cleansed from your sins, you should be afraid of Jesus.

As we read on, we discover in verse 15 that the herdsmen and the people in the surrounding country were also afraid of Jesus. They saw the once demon possessed man, now clothed and in his right mind, and they saw how the demons had drowned the herd of pigs. They had discovered the awesome power of Jesus, and reacted in fear. They did not want to learn any more about him, and asked him to depart from their region.

We must not be afraid of Jesus' power. He has the power to free us from our sins. We should not be afraid to learn all we can about Jesus, and allow him to rule our lives.

Finally, we see the reaction of the once demon possessed man in verses 18-20. This man was not afraid of Jesus. We read that he begged to be allowed to stay with Jesus, and then in verse 20, "He went away and began to proclaim in the Decapolis how much Jesus had done for him, and everyone marveled."

We should not be afraid to learn about Jesus, follow Jesus, or tell others about Jesus. Jesus has done great things for us. He has freed us of our sins. We must not be afraid to spread the exciting news!
