From Tyler's Desk:

Beware of Dogs!

Have you ever been out jogging, or just walking down the street, and suddenly, some huge dog, with big sharp teeth starts running after you as fast as it can. Scary huh?

Now imagine you were out walking one evening, and suddenly a huge pack of say 10 or 12 dogs started chasing after you. Big dogs. Mean dogs. Hungry dogs, who are clearly letting you know that you're not welcome in their territory. For most of us, if we found ourselves in such a situation, we would be terrified, looking for the quickest way to find shelter, and get away from those dogs.

Psalm 59 was written by David when his house was surrounded by men sent by King Saul; men looking for David to kill him (I Samuel 19:11-17). In this Psalm, David compares his situation to being surrounded by wild dogs. He says in verses 14-15, "Each evening they come back, howling like dogs and prowling about the city. They wander about for food and growl if they do

not get their fill."

David was constantly on the run from King Saul. As soon as he would escape from Saul's men, they would be right back, ready to kill him again. These dogs kept coming back "each evening". They were loud. They were terrifying. David knew his life was in danger. They were hungry for David's life, and would "growl" if they did not get what they wanted.

In the Old Testament, salvation had more of a physical meaning. David's life was physically being threatened. However, for us in New Testament times, our enemies from which we need deliverance are those of sin and spiritual death.

Isn't it true that sometimes it seems like Satan likes to keep throwing temptations at us. "Each evening they come back, howling like dogs". Like dogs, temptations seem to surround us. Temptations seem to howl at us, and tell us that they won't shut up until they "get their fill".

David escaped from these "dogs" by making God his fortress (verses 9, 17). Although David says he was surrounded by dogs each evening, he says "But I will sing of your strength; I will sing aloud of your steadfast love in the morning" (vs.16).

When we are surrounded by dogs, we should seek our refuge in God as our fortress. Then, once the morning comes, and the dogs are gone, we too can sing of God's strength and steadfast love.
