



## From Tyler's Desk

#### Miracles in Mark: The Miracle of Judgment

When you think of the miracles of Jesus, what do you typically think of? Water to wine? Healing the lame? Giving sight to blind? When we think of the miracles of Jesus, we usually think of His mercy. He had mercy on lepers. He had mercy on the sick. He had mercy on the deaf.

Although it is true that a vast majority of Jesus' miracles highlight His mercy, the miracle of Jesus recorded in Mark chapter eleven emphasizes another aspect of His authority. It shows his judgment. Jesus showed that he had the power to inflict punishment.

It was the Monday of Jesus' last week on earth. He and his disciples were traveling into Jerusalem from the suburb of Bethany. They were hungry. Mark 11:13 mentions that Jesus saw a fig tree off in the distance, and could see that it had leaves. Since fig trees usually showed fruit blooms before growing leaves, Jesus was hopeful that he had found lunch.

However, as Jesus arrived at the tree, it was apparent that this tree didn't have any fruit at all; it had nothing but leaves. Jesus then cursed the fig tree by stating "May no one ever eat fruit from you again!"

By the next morning, the tree was withered away (Mark 11:20). Through His miracles, Jesus showed time and time again that He had the power of God. He had the power to heal, the power to save, but we must not forget that he also had the power to condemn to death.
