From Tyler's Desk:

The God Given Home

In the last several bulletin articles we have been discussing the providence of God. God is able to provide for us, and He has promised us He will provide. Although there may be times (especially difficult times in our lives) where we may not see God's care, we can still trust He will provide.

But we must also remember that God's providence is only promised when we choose to live our lives according to the way God instructs us.

One of the very first ways in which God showed his providence to man was in the creation of the family. In Genesis chapters 1-2 we read about the creation of the world. When God first created Adam, He observed that "It is not good that man should be alone" (Gen. 2:18). We then read that God provided Adam with a helper fit for Him, that being Eve.

From the very beginning God has provided mankind with the blessing of a family. In Proverbs 18:22 we read, "He who finds a wife finds a good thing and obtains favor from the LORD." In the next chapter we read that "A prudent wife is from the LORD" (Prov. 19:14).

God has also reminded us that "children are a heritage from the LORD, the fruit of the womb a reward." (Psalm 127:3).

The home is a gift from God. And since the home originated with God, doesn't it make since

that God would know how this blessing can best be appreciated?

In the fifth chapter of Ephesians, God has instructed the husband to be the head of the wife. He has instructed wives to be submissive to their husbands. And He has instructed the husband to love his wife in the same way Christ loves the church. At the beginning of chapter 6, children are instructed to obey and honor their parents. Fathers are then instructed not to provoke their children to anger, but to bring them up in "discipline and instruction of the LORD."

When the family functions as God has planned, it can be a tremendous blessing. Thank God for the provision of the home.
