God Provides an Escape

When Jesus was teaching his disciples how to pray, He instructed them to pray, "lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil" (Matt. 7:13). If we will pray for deliverance, God has promised to provide us with that way of escape!

God promises this way of escape in I Corinthian 10:13. "No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation provides a way of escape, that you may be able to endure it."

Although we know we can rely on God's promise, there are times in life where this verse may not "seem" to be true. For example, I have a song on my computer by the band "DreamTheater" written about overcoming alcohol addiction. The song describes this addiction as a "glass prison" with no visible escape. Where is God's escape for the alcoholic?

The same could probably be said for any kind of addiction. Whether it be drugs, pornography, or simply bad language, a way of escape is not always visible. Even for those who would not call themselves "addicts" of anything, Christians may often feel as if no matter how hard they try, they can never be "good enough". Satan has such a strong grip on our world. How can we escape from sin and live holy lives?

Thankfully, when we cannot see a way of escape, we can know that God understands. Proverbs 3:5-6 reads, "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths." There are times when we will not be able to see an escape while leaning on our own understanding. But God has promised that if we trust and obey Him, even when we do not understand, that He will make our paths straight.

If we will trust God's guidance with each choice we make, we can trust that God, in His faithfulness, will provide us with an escape from sin.
