Be Careful In Asking

"But Jesus answered and said, "You do not know what you ask." (Matthew 20:22 NKJV). James and John (along with their mother) had asked for positions of honor in the Lord's Kingdom. Along with that came suffering which they could not envision. Paul observed, "For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought" (Romans 8:26 NKJV). Frequently one finds himself pleading to God for the wrong things. James writes, "You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures." (James 4:3 NKJV).

What do these verses communicate? One should think carefully about the things for which he prays. Does one realize that with some blessings also come great challenges? For instance, with wealth comes the temptation to trust in that wealth (Mark 4:19; I Tim. 6:17). Even good looks have their own challenges; just ask Sarah and Absalom. Even those who preach and desire to do so effectively must be careful. The eloquence of Apollos evidently led some to follow him as a person (I Cor. 1:12; 3:4). Pour your heart out to God, just be careful for that which you ask!
