Dress For Success

I love spending my mornings sitting around in sweat pants, a flannel shirt and socks, just drinking coffee and reading. But while my pajamas are comfortable, I always end up changing into something more presentable before getting started on my agenda for the day. In order to have a productive day, the first step is to get dressed.

In the Roman church, there were some Christians who weren't yet dressed for "spiritual success." In Romans 13:11-14, Paul instructed the church to "cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light." He goes on to define these "pajamas" we are supposed to cast off as various desires of the flesh. He tells us that we put on our "armor of light" when we "put on the Lord Jesus Christ."

As a whole, our world is not dressed for success. Many approach life with the attitude of "what will I get out of this" or "what will make me feel good". Sometimes this attitude is also present in the church. In fact, every one of us probably struggles with this attitude from time to time.

When we struggle with this attitude, we should remind ourselves of the words of Paul. "You know the

time, that the hour has come for you to wake from sleep. For salvation is nearer to us now than when we first believed."

Not only should we put off the works of darkness, but we need to dress ourselves in Jesus Christ. We need to take on his attitudes, his faith, his love, and live by his teachings. Being dressed in Jesus Christ excludes the possibility of being dressed in our own desires. Are you dressed for success?
