

From Tyler's Desk:

Does Jesus Recognize You?

Its often easy to tell where a person is from by simply observing their style of dress, language or accent. Jesus opened the Sermon on the Mount by listing various characteristics by which a citizen of his kingdom could be recognized. This section of Scripture is most often referred to as the beatitudes (Matthew 5:2-10).

Citizens of His kingdom should be easily recognized, for they are poor in spirit; they have a humble opinion of themselves. They mourn, but not in the same way others mourn; in their mourning they seek comfort from God. They are meek; their strength is under control. Their great desire for righteousness can be described as "hunger" and "thirst." They extend mercy, even towards those who don't deserve it. They are pure in heart; someone who is sincere, honest, and without hypocrisy. They are peacemakers, having devoted themselves to making peace, just as their Father has done. And finally they are willing to be persecuted for righteousness' sake.

As a unit, the beatitudes make one point very clear. A citizen of the kingdom of heaven is different from others in the world. A person cannot enter into God's kingdom without allowing themselves to be changed.

Do you exhibit the characteristics of a Christian? Are you different from others in the world? Based on this description, can Jesus recognize you as a citizen of His kingdom?
