What Kind Of Shoe Best Describes You?

HOUSESHOES — This person wants things easy, comfortable. He is scared off by the building program, mission work, benevolent work, etc. They can't worship in bad weather. "Woe unto them that are at ease in Zion" (Amos 6:1).

SANDAL — Just a skeleton of a Christian; didn't grow into well-rounded service. "As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby" (I Peter 2:2).

SUNDAY SHOE — Once-a-week Christians. "If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me" (Luke 9:23).

WORK SHOES — The active Christian who is always on the job for the Lord. "I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh when no man can work" (John 9:4). "Son, go work today in my vineyard" (Matthew 21:28).

We should all remember: "Today (NOW) is the day of salvation..." (II Corinthians 6:2). May we ask again, what kind of shoe best describes you?
