Wisdom

The Bible says, "*If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him*" (James 1:5). Oh how I need this. Life has too many decisions to make not to ask God for wisdom. Most of the mistakes we make in life have

to do with wrong decision.

What is wisdom? There are definitions as is seen here: "*Knowledge of what is true or right coupled with just judgment as to action*" (Dictionary.com). My definition of wisdom is the right action based on the right knowledge.

As a preacher wisdom is needed. It is needed in deciding the needs of the congregation that are to be addressed from the pulpit. Your audience varies. Some need to hear the plan of salvation while others need encouragement to make a public confession of wrong. Some are troubled (Gal. 6:2). Others need to be fed meat (Heb. 5:12-14). A preacher must pray for wisdom.

Parents need wisdom. It is no simple task to rear children (Eph. 6:4). A lot of pressure is on them from the world and it takes the wisdom of Job to know what to do. Children will want to do things and you as a parent are not sure whether it is the right thing to do. It may not be a matter of sin but a matter of judgment. Parents pray for wisdom.

Elders need wisdom. One of the most difficult tasks in the church is to be an elder (1 Peter 5:1-5). In matters of judgment everyone will not be pleased with a decision, therefore it takes wisdom to determine the right direction.
