

Airplane Mode In Church

There was a time when passing notes in church among teenagers was a serious problem in many churches. Perhaps this is still true but they no longer need the paper and it doesn't matter if they are on the other side of the auditorium or even at another church. With the proliferation of digital devices has come the ability to "text" a person a short message almost anywhere, including during worship services. The newer sophisticated *smart phones* also have the ability to send and receive email, surf the web and watch videos.

Periodically I must travel by airplane when going on our overseas tours, or even recently when going on the mission trip to Canada. At the beginning of the flight the stewardess will give the safety announcement about seat belts, floatation devices and oxygen masks in case of loss of cabin pressure. In addition they now ask that all electronic devices be turned off or placed in "Airplane Mode." The safety of all the passengers on the plane is at stake and especially during take off and landing no one should desire to interfere with the plane's ability to communicate with the air traffic control.

Perhaps there should be a new term developed, "Church Mode." During worship you may use your electronic device to read the Scriptures, or even take notes on the lesson. However, in "Church Mode" your device should NOT be used for texting, emailing, shopping online, watching videos or playing games. Not only does such interfere with your ability to hear the soul-saving message of God's word, but such also interferes with other's ability to hear and pay attention.

Recently several have complained about electronic devices being used near them in church and such being distracting. Some may think, this is just those disrespectful youth who can't put those devices down. However, those who have lodged these complaints have noted that those doing so were adults. As adults we should set the proper example for the youth. Parents remind your children of the importance of paying attention. Put your device in "Church Mode."
