



## **Communication Is Key**

Practically every counselor will tell you that the key to a successful marriage is for husbands and wives to communicate well with each other. One may not realize it but the same is true for being a successful Christian as well. There must be good communication between God and man.

The Bible is the way God speaks with man (Heb. 1:1-2; ICor. 2:12-13; IPet. 4:11; 2Tim. 3:16-17). The problem that man often faces is that he does not listen. "Why do you not understand My speech? Because you are not able to listen to My word." John 8:43 Thus Jesus says, "Therefore take heed how you hear." (Lk. 8:18) and "Take heed what you hear." (Mk. 4:24). Prayer is the way God listens to us. Again, we corrupt that communication by sin. "Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, That it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, That it cannot hear. But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear." Isaiah 59:1-2. How is your communication with God?
