

Motivation

People have different reasons for acting as they do. Some want to please men, so their decisions and actions are geared toward accomplishing this. Others want fame or fortune, so they devote their time and energy toward this end. Still others strive please themselves, so their days are spent doing the things that make them happy. But what should motivate the Christian? The writer of Proverbs provides an answer. He wrote: "In mercy and truth atonement is provided for iniquity; and by the fear of the Lord one departs from evil" (Proverbs 16:6).

Christians should not be motivated to live in a particular fashion because they desire to please others, because they want to gain fame or fortune, or because they want to please themselves. Instead, Christians should be motivated to live as they should because they want to please God. As the proverb correctly says, "by the fear of the Lord one departs from evil."

It is also interesting to note that this proverb states that "in mercy and truth atonement is provided for iniquity." The word "atonement" refers to the process whereby man's sins are covered by a sacrifice offered to God. Thus, man, who was estranged from God by his sins, is made at one with God. But where is this atonement found? It is found in mercy and truth. God has been merciful to man, and He expects man to be merciful to others (Matthew 5:7). And the truth of God will free all men who obey it (John 8:32). So what should man's motivation be? Man should be motivated by the hope of forgiveness that exists in mercy and truth, and man should live his life with the intention of pleasing God.
