## Youth News

We had seven participate in the Bible Bowl on Sunday at the East End congregation. We tied for second place with 3 other congregations. Our youth are doing a great job of studying the Bible to know the answers to the questions. I believe that two of the questions that they missed were not because they did not know the answer, but because of how it was worded. But I may be a little biased though. We are now about to begin to study Matthew chapters 17-20 in preparation for our next Bible Bowl. The day of the Bible Bowl we meet at the building around 12:30-12:45 to study and I have been trying to give them a practice test. Either true or false questions, matching or multiple choice. If you would like to write down a few questions that I could include I would appreciate it. That way they are getting different questions from a different perspective. I normally come up with about 20-30 questions on each test. I try to ask several questions from each chapter that we are studying. If you would like to contribute, you can email them to me, write them down, or text them to me, whatever works best for you.

**Mission Trip Information:** Latin American Missions (LAM) for short

If you plan on going on the mission trip with us to Granada, Nicaragua July 20-28 2018 please read this and start your process.

1. Begin praying that this will be a successful trip. By that I mean the Gospel will be spread and people may have their hearts pricked by the Word of God and obey it.
2. See Aaron so you can get registered ASAP due to limited spots. It only takes about five minutes per person.
3. Get a passport ASAP - You can do it online <https://travel.state.gov/content/travel/en/passports/apply-renew-passport/how-to-apply.html> - or go to the post office or the county clerk's office for the paperwork then you will have to go somewhere and have your picture taken. It will cost you \$110-125 for one passport. Once

you have submitted all of your information correctly it will take 4-6 weeks to get it back. That is why we need to get this done quickly.

4. LAM recommends getting a Hepatitis A and Tetanus shots before going on any trip with them.
5. Raise your money for the trip. We have to have at least \$1000 per person by the end of January to send to LAM for them to buy our plane tickets and reserve our spot and hotel rooms.
6. I am guessing that it will cost around \$2500. That would include everything but your money for souvenirs. Will know more in the upcoming weeks. I know this is a lot of money, but if you will look at it as an investment into the people going. They will grow, they will have a different outlook on life and will have a deeper respect and understanding of God's word. They will also feel more confident in teaching others the Gospel.
7. If you think you want to go but are not sure let me know. I will be glad to answer any questions and explain what a normal day will be like.

If you can not go on the trip physically, you can still pray for the campaign and support it by giving money for the group to go. If we have any money left over we will use it towards buying Spanish Bibles and or other things that the congregation may need.
