The Rock Higher Than I

David said, “From the end of the earth I will cry to You, When my heart is overwhelmed; Lead me to the rock that is higher than I.” (Ps. 61:2).

David was often in situations that overwhelmed him. He was hotly pursued by Saul seeking his life. He faced rebellion in his son Absalom and fled for his life. David also suffered greatly from the guilt of his sin with Bathsheba. One need only to read the Psalms to see the heart of this king who was a “man after God's own heart.”

Yet, David knew there was One to whom he could go for solace in times of life's storms. He spoke of a “rock that is higher than I.” But who or what is the Rock of which speaks? Frequently a person who has experienced a number of physical challenges in life will say of their husband, wife, son, daughter or some other close person, “they have been my rock.” In describing such a person they are saying that they have always been there for them. They are one upon whom they have depended. For David (and us) this Rock is the Lord. Later in this chapter David will say, “In God is my salvation and my glory; The rock of my strength, And my refuge, is in God.” (Ps. 62:7). And in another Psalm, “Oh come, let us sing to the LORD! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation.” (Ps. 95:1). Paul identified the Rock that traveled with the Israelites as Christ (1 Cor. 10:4).

Jesus is the Rock higher than I. In times when you are overwhelmed, go to Him!
