

Can You Find It? ...

Christ exhorted, "Search the scriptures" (John 5:39). The Bereans were noble for, along with receiving the Word with all readiness, they "searched the scriptures daily" (Acts 17:11). Today, we should heed the Lord's exhortation and emulate the example of the Bereans. Kind reader, as you "search the scriptures," can you find the following?

The name you wear in religion? Remember, speaking of the name Christ, "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved" (Acts 4:12). In searching the Scriptures, can you find,

The church of which you are a member?

If the Bible is our road map from earth to heaven, how can we expect to reach the desired destination being a member of some institution whose name does not even appear in its pages? Think it over! In searching the Scriptures, can you find,

The worship you render? Can you present divine authority and sanction for the burning of incense, washing of feet and instrumental music in worship to God today? Where is the Scripture? In searching the Scriptures, can you find,

The confession you made? What confession did you make before you were baptized? Did you confess, "I believe that God for Christ's sake has pardoned my sins?" Can you find it in the Bible? In searching the Scriptures, can you find,

The baptism to which you submitted? Did you have water sprinkled or poured upon you when you were an infant—or maybe later? Can you find book, chapter and verse from the Scripture for such a practice in the Christian age? Where can we read that sprinkling is baptism or that infants are proper subjects for such? Also, if you were baptized because you were already saved, where do you read of such in the Bible? In conclusion, we ask, can you be satisfied rapidly and speedily marching toward eternity having patterned your life after matters which you cannot find in the Scriptures? This is a serious matter!

"Is Pastor In?"

It happens frequently. The telephone rings at the office and a salesperson on the other end asks, "Is pastor in?" You can hear the affect and respect in people's voices when they reference to "pastor." Now, being a preacher, I appreciate being appreciated. BUT, the preacher is not "the pastor" and we should not call him "pastor."

The apostle Paul wrote, "And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers" (Ephesians 4:11). Note that "evangelists" and "pastors" are different! Someone might say, "Yes, but the local preacher is the pastor." Not correct! The word translated "pastors" (poimen) means "shepherds." The same word is translated "Shepherd" in Hebrews 13:20 and I Peter 2:25. The Hebrews passage tells us that Jesus is the "great Shepherd of the sheep." The I Peter passage tells us that Jesus is "the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls."

Contrary to the denominational view and practice, the elders of the local congregation – not the preacher – are the pastors! In Acts 20 Paul addressed "the elders of the church" (verse 17). He exhorted to them: "Take heed to yourselves and to all the flock among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood" (verse 28). Here the word "shepherd" (poimaino) is used in reference to elders, not the preacher. In I Peter 5 Peter addressed "the elders" (verse I). He exhorted them: "Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock. Again, the word "shepherd" (poimaino) is used in reference to elders, not the preacher.

We ought to do Bible things in Bible ways and call Bible things by Bible names! The elders are the shepherds (pastors) and overseers (bishops) of the local congregation. Preachers are not "pastors" or "bishops" unless they meet the qualifications set forth in I Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:5-9 and are appointed to serve as such. By the way, the New Testament teaches that there is always a plurality of elders in each congregation (Acts 14:23).

The conversation usually goes something like this: The salesperson asks, "Is pastor in?" I respond, "Sorry, none of our elders are available to speak to you at this time." They don't know what to think! They've never heard what the Bible teaches about the elders, not preachers being "pastors." But you have... "Pastor is not in!"
