The Scourge Of Secularism

What is "secularism"? Collins English Dictionary defines it as "a system of social organization and education where religion is not allowed to play a part in civil affairs." The American Heritage Dictionary defines it as "the view that religious consideration should be excluded from civil affairs and public education." "Secularism" is impacting America! We know that there are powers, overtly and covertly, working to remove all references to and influences of "religion" from our society. The Bible is not allowed in our schools. Evolution is touted; creation is mocked. Every form of immorality is promoted; morality is belittled. Situation ethic reigns supreme; biblical morality is called "a thing of the past." "You have your truth and I have my truth." "There are no absolutes!" "Everyone is right; no one is wrong." "Everything is right; nothing is wrong." Therefore, "every man does what is right in his own eyes" (Deuteronomy 12:8).

The toxicity of "secularism" is destroying the America we love. Our society is becoming more "secular" all of the time. Many now call our country "a Post-Christian Nation." Most religious organizations (churches) are in decline. Membership, attendance and involvement are down. How bad is it? The Barna Group recently published these facts:

I) "Nearly two-fifths of the nation's adult population (38%) now qualifies as post-Christian..."

2) "In other words, in spite of our 'Christian' self-descriptions, more than one-third of America's adults are essentially secular in belief and practice."

3) "Twenty years ago two-thirds of churchless Americans (65%) were open to being invited to church by a friend. Today, that percentage has slipped to less than half (47%)."

4) "Church-going is slowly but incontrovertibly losing its role as a normative part of American life."

5) "When the unchurched were asked to describe what they believe are the positive and negative contributions in America, almost half (49%) could not identify a single favorable impact of the Christian community..."

6) "The younger the generation, the more post-Christian it is. Nearly half of the Millennials (48%) qualify as post-Christian..." (www.barna.com/research/five-trends-among-the-unchurched/)

How is the "secularization" of America affecting the Lord's church? Many of our congregations are admittedly in decline, in membership and attendance. Church growth is more than a challenging in a society saturated with religious indifference. While we are alarmed, we must stay the course! We must hold to the truth, faithfully proclaim and live it!

One of the most troubling things is how "secular" many members of the church have become. For example, when given the choice between attending a ball game, a concert, a family reunion or a recital instead of being at worship, it is "no problem" for those who are "secular." Tell them that they are "secular," not "spiritual," and they will become angry! But it is true! Merriam-Webster defines "secularism" as "indifference to or rejection or exclusion of religion and religious consideration." When one is indifferent to, rejects and/or excludes the will of God things of the world, he or she is secular! "Secular" is just another name for "worldly." Are you seeking "first" the kingdom of God and His righteousness (Matthew 6:33)? We need to stifle this terrible scourge!
