

Why "Go To Church?"

In a "Letters to the Editor" column of a certain newspaper, a churchgoer had written this letter complaining that it made no sense to attend church every Sunday. He wrote, "I've gone for thirty years now, and in that time, I have heard something like 3000 sermons. But for the life of me I can't remember a single one of them. So, I think I'm wasting my time, and the preachers are wasting theirs by giving sermons at all." This resulted in an outpouring of letters for the column, which continued for weeks until someone wrote the following: "I've been married for 30 years now. In that time my wife has cooked some 32,000 meals. But for the life of me. I cannot recall the entire menu for a single one of those meals. But I do know this: They all nourished me and gave me the strength I needed to do my work. If my wife had not given me these meals, I would be physically dead today. Likewise, If I had not gone to church for nourishment, I would be spiritually dead today!"

What benefits are there to assembling each week with other believers in Christ to worship God? While some choose to attend a church because of entertainment that might be provided, a Christian should have more legitimate motives than this. A few to be considered would be—

• Attending where the true gospel is preached, one learns of the salvation God has provided, and the proper response for one's salvation. (Romans 1:16; 5:1-6, 18: 6:3-4)

- As a Christian one has a treasured opportunity to remember Christ in the weekly partaking of the Lord's supper as He instructed (I Corinthians 15:23-26; Acts 20:7).
- One is instructed and edified by the teaching and preaching of God's Word (Acts 20:22; 2 Timothy 4:1-4; Matthew 4:4).
- One is privileged to worship God, and at the same time encourage fellow-believers (Acts 2:42; Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16; Hebrews 10:25).

To do otherwise is to ignore a command of Scripture: "Let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another as ye see the day approaching" Hebrews 10:24-25).
