## Statement from Elders Regarding COVID-19 Virus

In light of the current events with regard to the spread of coronavirus, we want to assure the congregation that we are closely monitoring the situation and have plans in place to help prevent the spread of the virus and protect the congregation.

### Below are actions that will be implemented immediately:

- Stay home if you are sick, be fever free for at least 24 hours before attending services.
- Avoid shaking hands.
- Door greeting will be suspended until further notice.
- Everyone is encouraged to follow all personal hygiene guidelines.

### Beginning next Sunday

- Communion will continue to be served using the trays, however, prepared individual cups will be provided for those interested. *(these may be picked up in the lobby as you enter the auditorium. Empty cups should be placed in the back of the pews)*
- The collection will be taken as usual with the passing of the trays.
- Services will be streamed on Facebook for those unable to attend in person.
- In the event of a confirmed case in Warren County, we will immediately suspend the passing of all trays. Prepared cups will be used for the communion and the offering will be collected as you exit the auditorium.

- The Gospel Meeting has been canceled.
- The Ladies' Day has been canceled.
