

Yet, when they reached the camp God had caused the Syrian army to flee in panic leaving all their tents and belongings behind.

The lepers enjoyed a feast of food, grabbed their choice of silver, gold and clothing. However, they realized something...they were being greedy hoarding all this stuff for themselves. Those in the city were hungry and they were simply being self-ish. They realized their obligation to tell the good news. We have the same obligation with the good new of the Gospel.
