### **Mind of Christ**

"Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others." (Philippians 2:3, 4)

The concept that Paul is expressing in the above Scripture is one that is very foreign to the world we live in. Sure there are plenty of good people out there, who, when faced with the dilemma of helping a fellow human in distress or turning a blind eye, will (or say they would) help out.

When it comes to the idea of "Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others", this is where the foreign concept is seen.

You see, the idea of looking out for the interest of others may require a person to avoid, look past or completely ignore their own feelings, opinions, time, scheduled activities (not doing what you had planned so that you can help another person) or any other variety of things that revolve around self.

We live in such a self centered world that the concept of sacrifice for others seems senseless and is not something we should be doing in this life.

This is where the mind of Christ comes in, you see, in verse 5 of the same chapter, Paul says these words "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,". Jesus looked at people differently. He saw people through the eyes of compassion.

The world does not see compassion, just "helping someone out every now and then". But compassion will lead a person to forsake their own personal interest and needs in order to provide for the needs of another.

Although the world is upside-down right now, let us always remember that we are to be like Christ. He felt and showed compassion for everyone. He even died for everyone. The least we can do is be kind.
