God’s Epitaph

Three men were asked, "When you are in your casket and friends and family are mourning you, what would you like to hear them say about you?" The first guy said, "I would like to hear them say that I was a great doctor and a great family man." The second guy said, "I would like to hear them say that I was a wonderful husband and school teacher who made a huge difference in our children of tomorrow."
