It's Only 5 Seconds

Last weekend at Challenge Youth Conference there was a statement that was made that has stuck with me. Lonnie Jones was speaking about giving your life over to God and used an illustration where he was tasered during a training exercise.

He said the pain only lasted five (5) seconds. He then was laid on the ground, got up and went about his day. He kept referring to this phrase “it's only five (5) seconds”.

This phrase “it's only five (5) seconds” got me to thinking about several different things.

1. When you are faced with temptation, the pleasure you get from the sin, how long does that pleasure last? “it's only five (5) seconds”.

2. When you compare life on this earth to how long we will be in eternity, this earthly life “it's only five (5) seconds”.

3. How long does it take to look at a person and say “Jesus loves you”? “it's only five (5) seconds”.

4. How much time does it take for your life to completely change for the better or the worse? “it's only five (5) seconds”.

Five (5) seconds is not a long amount of time, as a matter of fact it will take you 13 five (5) seconds to read this article (that's 65 seconds).

When you surrender your life to God and are baptized, the baptism “it's only five (5) seconds”.
