## God Speaks Through His Son

At one time God spoke to his people through Hebrew prophets, spokesmen for God who were charged to deliver the receive message without addition, subtraction, substitution, alteration or modification. In the gospel dispensation Jehovah speaks through his Son, no longer speaking by Moses, for he is not the lawgiver under Christianity. Nor does he speak through Old Testament prophets for they are not Jehovah's official spokesmen for the current dispensation either. Likewise, modern priests, popes, rabbis, preachers, bishops, self-appointed prophets and so-called apostles are not his official spokesmen today. God speaks through his Son and what that Son says is found in the New Testament. His commissioned apostles and inspired ministers of the first century set into the permanency of writing the fulness of his will and the totality of his message of redemption for man.

## Hebrews 1:1-2

"God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds"
