Making Room in the Flock

Walking into a congregation for the first time can be intimidating. Visitors may wonder, *Will anyone speak to me? Will I fit in? Will I be welcomed?* New members may have similar feelings as they try to find their place within a new church family. As Christians, we have an opportunity—and a responsibility—to make sure they know they are valued.

The Bible repeatedly emphasizes hospitality and fellowship. Paul wrote, "Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving

preference to one another... given to hospitality" (Romans 12:10, 13). Hospitality is more than shaking someone's hand at the church building. It means opening our lives to others and helping them become part of the family.

Sometimes that requires us to step outside our comfort zone. It is easy to talk with the same people every Sunday, sit with the same friends, and spend time with those we already know. But what about the visitor sitting quietly across the aisle? What about the new member who does not yet have close friendships within the congregation?

Jesus taught us to look beyond our familiar circles. He said, "By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:35). That love should be visible in the way we welcome people into our fellowship.

Something as simple as saying, "Would you like to go eat with us after worship?" can make a tremendous difference. Invite a new member into your home for a meal. Ask a visiting family to join you for lunch. Sit beside someone you do not normally sit with. Learn their names, ask about their lives, and take a genuine interest in them.

Peter instructed Christians, "Be hospitable to one another without grumbling" (1 Peter 4:9). Hospitality does not require an impressive home, an expensive meal, or elaborate plans. It simply requires an open heart and a willingness to make room for someone else.

Remember, we are not merely trying to increase attendance; we are building relationships within the family of God. Paul described Christians as "members of the household of God" (Ephesians 2:19). A household should be a place where people know they belong.

This week, look beyond your normal circle. Find a visitor or new member. Introduce yourself. Invite them to lunch. Open your home. Include them in your life.

Sometimes helping someone feel at home in the church begins by inviting them into ours.
