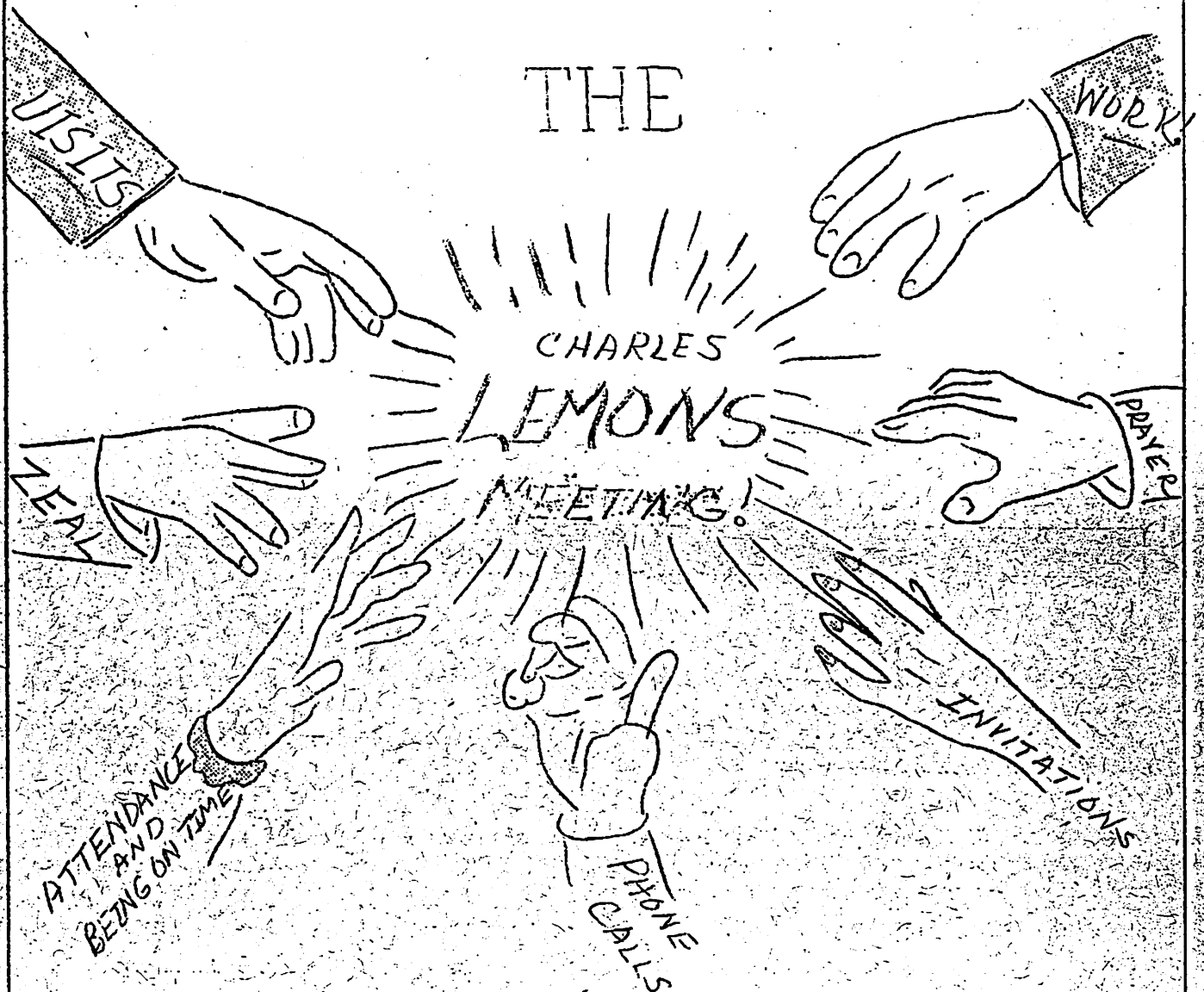

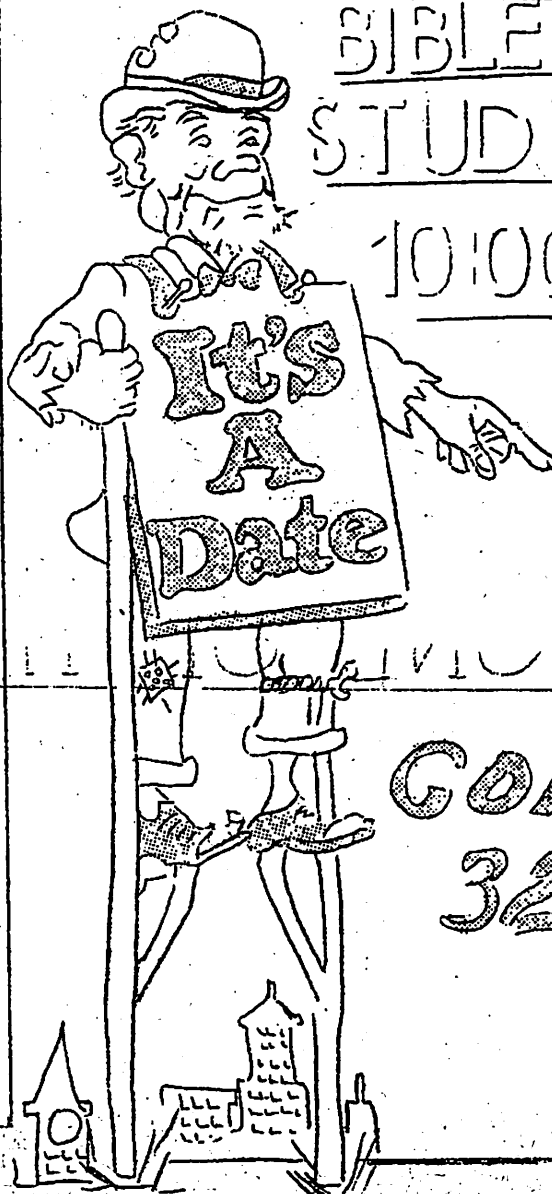

NEWS NOTES

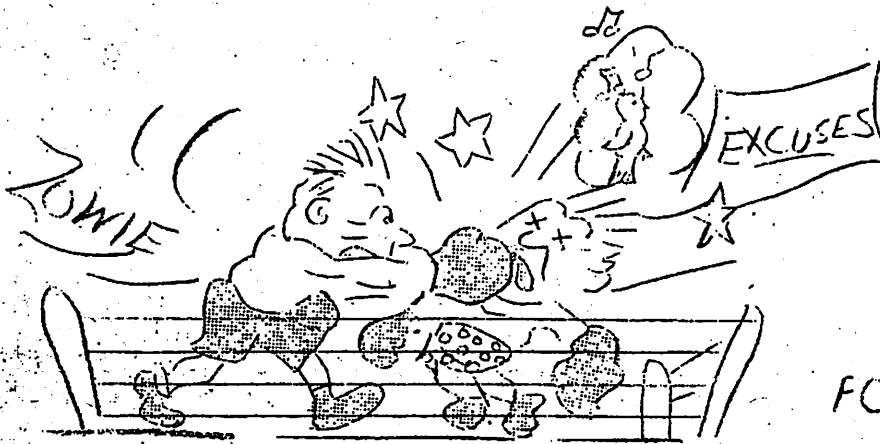
